## Fabric Requirements

This is for the mystery and non-mystery quilters alike :)

## Fabric Requirements

|            | Baby                                       | Throw                     |
|------------|--|---------------------------|
| quilt size | 42" × 42"                                  | 54" × 66"                 |
|            |  |                           |
| neutral 1  | 1 ¼ yards                                  | 2 yards                   |
| neutral 2  | 1 yard                                     | 1 ½ yards                 |
| color 1    | ¾ yard                                     | 1 ½ yards                 |
| color 2    | 1 yard                                     | 1 ¾ yards **              |
| accent     | ¾ yard                                     | 1 ¼ yards                 |
|            |  |                           |
| backing *  | 2 ¾ yards<br>(horizontal)<br>or 1 ½ yards+ | 3 ¼ yards<br>(horizontal) |
| binding    | ½ yard                                     | ½ yard **                 |
| batting *  | 46" × 46"                                  | 60" × 70"                 |

\* The batting and backing sizes are calculated with a 2" overlap on all sides.

Your personal preference or the requirements of your longarmer may vary.

+ The yardage is slightly too small but the best choice if adjusted by inserting an extra strip e.g. of extra blocks or scraps.

\*\* Calculations are for this yardage exactly. You might want to consider adding some extra.

Unless otherwise specified, yardages are based on fabric at least 42" wide. Please also notice that this pattern is written for non-directional fabrics/prints - solids or blenders are recommended.

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**Note:** Each quilter has a different preference on the size of the fabric piece relative to the size of the FPP block section. This pattern plans for roughly ½" seam allowance so that there is wiggle room.

Please make a test block if you are unsure. Also be aware that the fabric amounts will vary if you decide to cut larger or smaller pieces.
