## Color Distribution

The pattern design was written with the idea of

- two neutral colors (N1 + N2)
- one main color in a set of two values or adjacent hues (C1 + C2)
- one accent color (A)

When playing with coloring ideas it became clear that some other combinations might work as well. Generally, those groupings still consist of a maximum of two color groups plus sometimes neutrals. Even a monochrome palette with enough contrast between all five colors worked well.

darker version of the neutral color

Color 1
lighter version of the main color here also an adjacent hue

darker version of the main color
here also an adjacent hue

Accent
a fitting accent color



The left one always reads lighter in the final design than the right one as fabric N1 is used more in the layout than fabric A.
